What are we doing?

To help us make the Soo Curlers Association website a positive place for everyone, we've been using the [Web Content Accessibility Guidelines \(WCAG\) 2.1](#). These guidelines explain how to make web content more accessible for people with disabilities, and user friendly for everyone.

The guidelines have three levels of accessibility (A, AA and AAA). We've chosen Level AA as the target for the Soo Curlers Association website.

How are we doing?

We're working hard to achieve our goal of Level AA accessibility, but we realise there are some areas that still need improving. The following information explains what we're doing to make that happen.

1.1.1: Non-text Content

Over the next year we will review all the non-text content on the website and put in place alternatives.

1.2.1: Audio-only and Video-only (Pre-recorded)

We will remove all time-based media from our website over the next 6 months

1.2.2: Captions (Pre-recorded)

Implement captions for all pre-recorded audio content.
